ABOUT OUR COURSE

The job opportunities for trained dental assistants are quite good in today's marketplace. While no one can guarantee job placement, the dental profession is currently facing a shortage of trained dental assistants, the majority require experience.

Following your training in this eleven week course, you will have the confidence and skills necessary to apply for these positions. Along with your diploma and x-ray certification, we will give you a letter of recommendation and a summary of your training experience.

Part of your training will involve the "Job Interview" itself. Learn how to prepare for it, how to dress and what to say. So often jobs are lost during the first five minutes of the interview. We feel it is important to train you in this area as well, so that you will stand out from the rest of those competing for that position.

Many doctors call our office asking for a list of our recent student graduates. We also inform our current class of any doctors needing Dental Assistants so that they may apply directly for the position. Many of our students have obtained jobs as dental assistants even before finishing the course.

The starting pay scale for experienced dental assistants is considerably higher than

someone with no experience. We are often asked what a graduate from our course can expect to make in their first job. The answer depends on where the office is located. Many times, offices in large cities pay higher than those in smaller cities or rural areas. Graduates of our course can expect to start well above the pay scale of those with no experience.
